

## **Successful acquisition of an Erasmus project “Development of innovative training solutions in the field of functional evaluation aimed at updating of the curricula of health sciences schools.”**

### **Summary**

Under the guidance of the Politechnika Slaska, Gliwice, Poland, AMSE has successfully been granted an Erasmus Project “Development of innovative training solutions in the field of functional evaluation aimed at updating of the curricula of health sciences schools”. The project will be financially supported from November 2018 to October 2020 with a total of 211.471 Euro. It is intended that the results of this project will be sustainable and they will be focused on enriching the training currently provided at health sciences schools, also facing the deficit of skills that Europe suffers today. Apart from Politechnika Slaska and AMSE the project consortium is formed by Instituto de Biomechanica de Valencia (SPAIN) and Universitat de Valencia (SPAIN).
