PROFESSOR DAVID GORDON – President of World Federation for Medical Education (WFME) since January 2015.

He is a former President of the Association of Medical Schools in Europe (AMSE) and is Emeritus Professor of Medicine.

He was dean of the Medical Faculty in Manchester for seven years, and Chair of the Council of Heads of Medical Schools in the UK.



PROFESSOR ROBIN STEVENSON, Glasgow University, UK -

an expert in CME/CPD, Editor-in-chief of the Journal of European CME (JECME.org) and former President of the European Board for Accreditation in Pneumology. He has recently published a book on CME-CPD -

"Learning and Behaviour in medicine - A voyage around CM and CPD" which gives a valuable insight into CME/CPD that is important for both expert faculty and learners.

PROFESSOR BOB HARRIS – Director of Doctoral Education at Karolinska Institute and past President of ORPHEUS, the Organization for PhD Education in Biomedicine and Health Sciences in the European System, which aims to stimulate quality assurance of PhD research and education and to strengthen career opportunities for PhD graduates.



DR. ALEXANDER HASGALL – Head of the EUA Council for Doctoral Education (EAU CDE) and responsible for a network of more than 240 European Universities from 35 countries, dedicated to the further development and strengthening of doctoral education and research training in Europe.



PROFESSOR JOHN CREEMERS - Director Doctoral School Biomedical Sciences, Laboratory of Biochemical Neuroendocrinology, Center for Human Genetics, KU Leuven, President of ORPHEUS.

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EBMA WORKSHOP



JOSÉ MIGUEL PÊGO is an Anesthesiologist and an Associate Professor at the School of Medicine, Braga, Portugal. He is also part of the Population Health Research Domain at Life and Health Sciences Research Institute, Braga, Portugal. He teaches Pharmacology, Anesthesiology, and Critical Care. He is mainly interested in the effects of chronic stress on emotional behavior and understanding the underlying mechanisms. He is also interested in the cognitive skills assessment process. He is certified by the National Board of Medical Examiners in the Foundations of Assessment in Medical Education (FAME) course and a member of the European Board of Medical Assessors. He is the founder and CEO of iCognitus, a spin-off company that specializes in written assessment software (QuizOne).



CARLOS FERNANDO COLLARES, M.D., M.SC., PH.D. is a professional specialized in psychometrics applied to assessment and learning, particularly in healthcare professions education. He has coordinated the implementation of a computerized adaptive international progress testing consortium for the European Board of Medical Assessors, where he was responsible for the entire testing cycle, from item development and review to post-test analyses and score reporting. His practical work has allowed medical schools worldwide to make strategic use of longitudinal assessments as a tool to foster student learning and provide useful information to institutional stakeholders for quality management, curricular governance and faculty development purposes. His research as Assistant Professor in the Department of Educational Development and Educational Research of the Faculty of Health, Medicine and Life Sciences at Maastricht University focuses on the validity and reliability of assessment tools, unidimensional and multidimensional item response theory, computerized adaptive testing, cognitive diagnostic modelling and network psychometrics. His main goal is to promote the use of technology to make assessment less traumatic but also more useful, engaging, motivating, valid, and reliable.

JANUSZ JANCZUKOWICZ - Vice dean for Education and Assessment Methodology, Medical University of Lodz; Head of Centre for Medical Education, Medical University of Lodz. An expert in Health profession education, medical and academic professionalism, social competence in healthcare and other medical education and human resources for health related topics and disciplines.
